Annual Health checks need to improve. They are not detailed enough. A GP at the Complex Needs group said how important they are. Two examples were given of waiting 3 years and another being overdue for complex needs.



Cllr Withers will highlight this in LD and Autism Steering Group.

Do self-advocates have health passports and a health plan? Health action plans should be given at annual health checks.

We had a short break

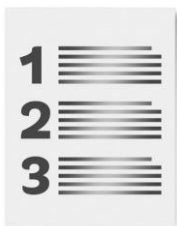


JW came to talk about a service user feedback form for Hampshire County Council.

Linden Farm is a project just completed to support people with Complex Needs and family respite. Designed to meet all needs

Discussed:

Hamberley Care has provision in Basingstoke, Southampton and Camberley and made an invite for parent carers to visit the facilities on offer.

Importance of regular therapies in maintaining well being and a further conversation about changing areas, such as no facilities on flights for this.

Want to raise issues so others can hear more voices. One self-advocate requested to visit the group to learn more about Complex Needs.

It would be good to get more parent carers involved.

A new hospital facility is needed to meet the demands of the future from lessons learnt in Covid.

Individual rooms needed – not open wards

Hospital transport talked about and available through neighbourhood care groups. First Wessex Community receive a grant to provide this.
