Meeting – Creating Keeping Safe Pack and other Easy Reads needed






- You said you want to make a toolkit for Staying Safe based on the survey feedback

- We talked about funding for Safe Places and we invited someone from Minstead who has been involved in the scheme to come to the next meeting










- Jay attended to talk about Safe Places and give ideas
