Adult Social Care Working Group You Said, We Did

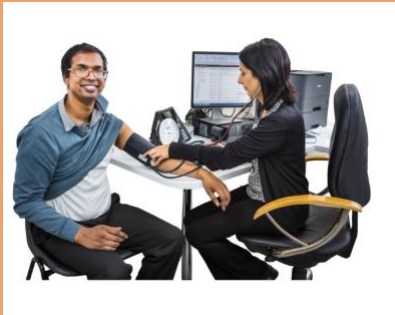


- There are two Devolution programmes

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You Said, We Did

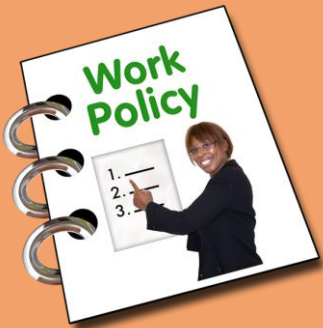
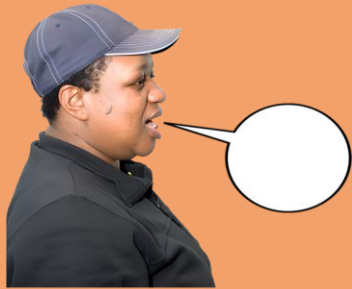


- Nicki joined the meeting to help us with the history of the LD Plan
