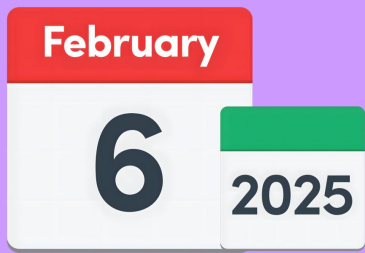

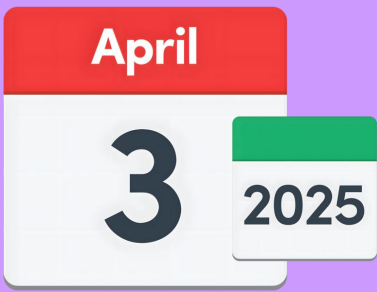


- Andrew said he is happy to support with Safe Places

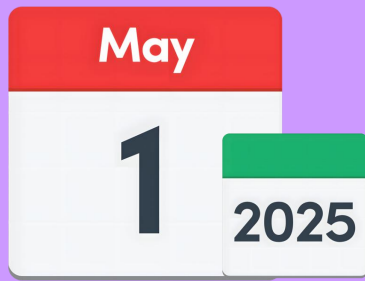


- We asked you to look out for Safe Places stickers and feedback where you found them in the next meeting

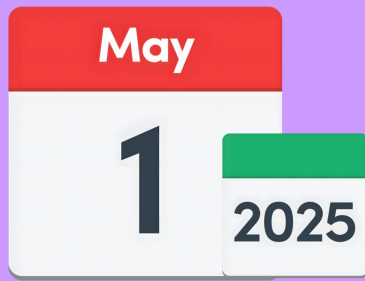

Being Safe Staying Safe You Said, We Did



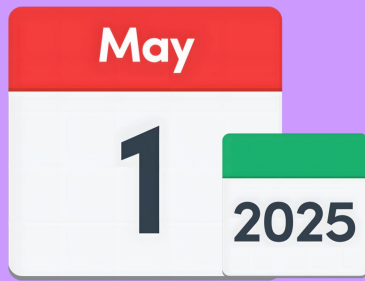
- Everyone introduced themselves and Ieuan from the Fire Service joined us today

Being Safe Staying Safe You Said, We Did

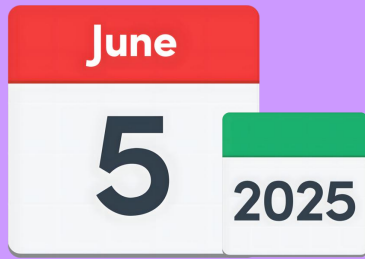


- We talked about LD week and that we need the 'Being Safe' Easy Read ready in time for sharing in this week
