




Everyone introduced themselves and wished each other a happy new year

 Member Schemes v2






- We said Safe Places would need assessing first

- We talked about Safe Places
- Jake shared about Safe Places in Eastleigh from their website
- Marcia saw a Sticker in Oxford for Safe Places and said it made her feel safe seeing the sticker
- Arun and Tanya said they will check in their areas, Richard is checking with the borough council as to what they have
- Richard said he would like local council to have a list of Safe Places





- We said anyone can use a safe place
- You said it is for people who might:
 - feel anxious, frightened, upset being stalked, feeling vulnerable
- You said good places would be Poppins (Marcia), Sainsburys, Police, Tesco local, library, Café republic (James to ask them)
- You suggested lots of places you could ask and will check with

- We talked about Safe Places

July





- You said some places you would like to be Safe Places:

- You said you would like to ask safe places:
 - Are you still one?
 - If not would you like to be?
 - Do you know what they are? (and offer training)
 - You would be keen to visit places to ask questions





- We showed the co-production video you made thank you to Marcia,
 Tanya and James
- We said National Safeguarding week is coming up 18 22 November if self-advocates would like to be involved or support this
- We said would anyone like to be on a survivor panel to support Hampshire County Council work on domestic violence
- We said The Social Worker Conference is 21 November 2024





We said we will share the Easy Read made on being safe in the dark

 You said Some more ideas about the dark — like wearing hi-vis jackets and spoke about keeping warm in the winter

 We said to bring your laptops and tablets to our meeting in August where Lee has offered to look at and fix them if he can

September 5





- You gave an update on speaking with GPs with Marta
- You said the GP sessions are good and they all meet together to hear from you
- We talked about annual health checks and an upcoming video





- You said about annual health checks
 - Sometimes you don't get blood tests taken
 - You don't get an action plan after the meeting
 - There is confusion on what a health check is called different things in different practices
 - You want to book in with a receptionist not a screen
 - Some said they have not had one for a while
 - Listen to people talk to them not carers/family
 - Should not always think they know better and assume
 - Not always look on record, sometimes it is wrong





- We said the videos on annual health checks will talk about
 - Explain why they are looking for things
 - Prepare people before they arrive
 - Give choices
 - What an annual health check is
 - It would be for people in Hampshire and Isle of Wight
- Nila told us more about the National Safeguarding Adults board in November

- We looked at the survey results together for the Hampshire Learning Disability Partnership survey
- You said people should feel safe and it was worrying that some people don't feel safe
- You said you would like to make a pack for people to use to feel safe
- You said you will talk to some local shops and the local councils about the Safe Places scheme before the next meeting



- You said we can share this anonymous data with Adults Health and Care from the survey
- You said you want to make contact with people who feel unsafe and have information ready to share
- You said you would like to make a pack for people to use to feel safe
- You said you want to find out who your local PSCO is
- You said it makes you feel safe when you see them in uniform



- You said PSCOs sometimes come along to your groups
- Donna said she could ask the Inspector to email some links and ask him who could come along to help
- Richard said he had his bike stolen two weeks ago and it was a nasty experience
- You said in the next meeting you want to talk about putting a keeping safe pack together

November

November

2024



- You said you would like to work on a 'keeping safe' pack in this group
- You said it is important people feel safe in Hampshire and important that they know what to do
- You said you would like in the pack
 - a wallet sized card with information,
 - a map of where to go for help
 - Ideas about CCTV and ring doorbells
 - Fire information about extinguishers, smoke alarms and wires
 - Pothole dangers and bikes





- We said we will put this together in the meetings
- You said you want the pack to be colourful and accessible
- You said you would like to tell people how to have a home safety check by video and on paper
- Farnborough has been working on safe places and a survey
- We said you may want to include mate crime





- You said you would like to do more work on safe places
- We said would you like to contact someone to help
- You said you would like to write a letter together from the Partnership to ask Donna Jones for some help to move it forwards
- You said you want to say in the letter why you think is it important to have safe places and what you will do to help make it happen
- You all said places you will check and feedback on safe places at the next meeting and you will ask if you need help to do this

December

December 2024



- You said you found out the PSCO in New Forest is Jack
- You said you have spoken about Safe Places and keeping safe in the Speak Out Farnborough group
- You said in the dark evenings you stay in and watch TV or do arts and crafts
- You said Sarah Jane and the buddy scheme might help you to go out more in the evenings
- We talked about what you would like in the Easy Read pack for Staying Safe and Trish shared the work done on this in the Farnborough group





- You said audio descriptions do not work in the cinema
- You said the Access Card is good <u>Access Card: Making access easy</u>
- You said you would like information in the pack to include:
 - Fire alarms
 - First aid kits
 - Cold calls/scammers
- You said you want to ask for help with Safe Places by writing a letter or making a video





- We asked you for examples of using Safe Places
- You said you know where there are some
- You said you feel safe when people help you
- You said seeing the safe places sticker in a different town made you feel safe
